Instructions: Do **both** A and B below.

A) Read Outliers by Malcolm Gladwell.

B) Fill out a “Double-Entry Journal”:

- Buy a black and white marble notebook.
- Fold a page in half.
- For **each chapter** of *Outliers* choose **3** sentences or phrases that capture your attention because of the sound, or the meaning, or the feeling that they stir in you.
- In the margin of your journal (that means to the left of the vertical red line) write the page number of each sentence/phrase you’ve chosen.
- In the next column write the exact sentence/phrase.
- In the last column write down your personal thoughts about the sentence/phrase. (Look on back of this page for example of format.)

Remember: You are to do **3** sentences/phrases for every chapter in the book including the *introduction* and the *epilogue*.

Due Date: On the first day of classes of sophomore year, hand the journal into your English teacher.
