

**St. Peter's Signum Fidei Chapter of the National Honor Society is now accepting applications. Students must exhibit the NHS pillars of scholarship, service, leadership, and character, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 88 with no subject grade below 72, and an exemplary disciplinary record. These will be verified through official school documents. Applicants must submit a service resume for each year of high school (that does not include donations of food, clothing, etc.) as well as a list of all school and community extracurricular activity (e.g. scouting, CYO, civic associations) indicating the number of years involved in these activities along with a contact name and address/phone number for verification. Participation in the following is incumbent upon all members:**

- **Weekly Society meetings and dues**
- **Administrative Office Assistance, Open House, Chinese Auction, Fashion Show, School Musical and other school events as needed**
- **Participation in all school raffle/fundraising campaigns and Society service commitments to outside agencies**
- **40 hours of Christian Service annually (peer tutoring and mandatory tutoring at affiliated Catholic elementary schools)**
- **Participation in the Lasallian Youth Group**
- **Enrichment curriculum (reading, plays, museums, STEM activities, etc.)**
- **Maintain the society's standard of academic achievement, integrity, and comportment**
- **Society endeavors are not optional and failure to fulfill obligations may result in dismissal**

**All activities and service commitments for 2020-21 are contingent on the prevailing social distancing regulations and will be updated accordingly in the future.**

**Students who meet the above criteria and consent to the stated obligations are invited to submit a letter detailing their desire for membership, what they can contribute to the Society, and any proposals for new Chapter projects, along with the required service and activity resume.
