Dear Student,

Congratulations! I am pleased to inform you that you have been accepted for admission to St. Peter's Boys High School based on the results of the TACHS Examination. Of course, your acceptance depends on the completion of all your elementary school requirements. Remember to thank the teachers of your elementary school for the preparation they have given you.

Freshman tuition for the 2022-2023 school year will be \$8,875. In addition, there is an academic fee of \$1,045 for book rental, student insurance, yearbooks, physical education uniform, locks, and a school I.D. Card. Each family is assessed a mandatory Fair Share quota of \$375 for our fund raising events. No other mandatory fees or appeals for money are required for the operation of St. Peter's Boys High School.

The following are the registration procedures:

- Return the enclosed Student Response Form no later than Friday, February 4th, with the requested Personal Information Sheet and a \$250 application fee payable by certified check or money order which is <u>non-refundable</u>. You can also submit the Response Form, Personal Information Sheet and the \$250 application fee online at stpetersboyshs.org.
- 2. Report for registration at St. Peter's on Thursday, March 3rd, between 2:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. At that time, you must bring a **certified check or money order for \$992.** This amount includes your July tuition payment (the first of your ten monthly installments), your son's school Nike Pullover and his orientation fee. Each subsequent month from August through April will require a **\$992** payment. This **non-refundable** tuition payment guarantees you a seat at St. Peter's Boys High School.

We offer bus transportation from the South Shore of Staten Island from Page Ave., Holy Child and Our Lady Star of the Sea R.C. Churches and plan on a bus from St. Patrick's Parish in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn. If interested in this bus service, please indicate so on your return response form.
