Dear Student,

Congratulations! I am pleased to inform you that you have been accepted for admission to St. Peter's Boys High School based on the results of the TACHS Examination. Of course, your acceptance depends on the completion of all your elementary school requirements. Remember to thank the teachers of your elementary school for the preparation they have given you.

Freshman tuition for the 2025-2026 school year will be \$9,575. In addition, there is an academic fee of \$1,085 for book rental, student insurance, yearbooks, physical education uniform, locks, and a school I.D. Card. Each family is assessed a mandatory Fair Share quota of \$375 for our fund raising events. No other mandatory fees or appeals for money are required for the operation of St. Peter's Boys High School.

The following are the registration procedures:

1. We ask that **ALL** accepted students go to our website homepage at: stpetersboyshs.org by **Friday, February 7th** and complete the Student Response Google Form. For those students accepting admission to St. Peter's - please use the payment link to **pay the non-refundable \$250 application fee**. Alternatively, students can use the link in their accepted email or call the school at 718-447-1676 to complete the registration.
2. Report for registration at St. Peter's on **Wednesday, March 5th, between 2:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M.** At that time, you must bring a **certified check or money order for \$1,066**. This amount includes your July tuition payment (the first of your ten monthly installments), your son's school Nike Pullover and his orientation fee. Each subsequent month from August through April will require a **\$1,066** payment. This **non-refundable** tuition payment guarantees you a seat at St. Peter's Boys High School.

We offer bus transportation from the South Shore and Brooklyn. Please see the enclosed letter on our bus service. If you are interested in this bus service, please indicate your response on the Google Form.
